

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The **Mayor and Council of the City of College Park** has tentatively adopted a General Fund millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by **2.70** percent.

The **Mayor and Council of the City of College Park** has tentatively adopted a Special District Property Tax millage rate of 14.5 mills, which represents a **.99** percent decrease in property taxes over the previous year.

The **Mayor and Council of the City of College Park** has tentatively adopted a Georgia International Convention Center Tax millage rate of 7.5 mills, which represents a **11.38** percent decrease in property taxes over the previous year.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at City of College Park City Hall, Council Chambers, 3667 Main Street, College Park, Georgia on **September 17, 2018 at 6:00 pm.**

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at City of College Park City Hall, Council Chambers, 3667 Main Street, College Park, Georgia on **October 1st, 2018 at 6:00pm and October 15th, 2017 at 7:30pm.**

This tentative increase will result in a General Fund millage rate of **12.619 mills**, an increase of **0.332 mills**. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than **12.287 mills**. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of **\$100,000** is approximately **\$7.97** and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of **\$300,000** is approximately **\$39.84**.
