AVAILABILITY:

Service is available throughout the limits of the City of College Park in accordance with the City’s applicable Ordinances, Rules & Regulations

APPLICABILITY:

Residential services are applicable to all domestic uses of the customer.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Service under this schedule includes the collection of domestic wastewater, at a single point of collection. Sewer service will be billed monthly based on the current month’s water meter reading, be it either an individual meter at a single family home or a master meter at a multi-family apartment or condominium complex.

MONTHLY SEWER CHARGES:

The total monthly residential sewer charge shall be the sum of the Wastewater Treatment Charge plus the Sewer Collection Charge.

TREATMENT CHARGE – ALL CUSTOMERS ⁽¹⁾

For all KGAL ⁽²⁾ @ \$3.57 per KGAL

COLLECTION CHARGE – SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENCES ⁽³⁾

Basic Facilities Charge @ \$5.38
 For the first 4 KGAL @ \$1.88 per KGAL
 For the next 4 KGAL @ \$2.69 per KGAL
 For greater than 8 KGAL @ \$3.50 per KGAL

COLLECTION CHARGE – MULTIFAMILY RESIDENCES ⁽⁴⁾

Basic Facilities Charge @ \$26.91
 For the first 3 KGAL per Unit @ \$1.88 per KGAL
 For the next 3 KGAL per Unit @ \$2.69 per KGAL
 For greater than 6 KGAL per Unit @ \$3.50 per KGAL

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE:

Shall be the applicable Basic Facilities Charge.

DEFINITIONS:

- (1) College Park procures wastewater treatment at the best available prices from other governmental agencies.
- (2) Each KGAL shown under the Monthly Sewer Charges is equivalent to 1,000 gallons as measured by the customer's water meter.
- (3) Single family residences include both owner-occupied and rented detached homes. Small multi-unit residences such as duplexes and quadraplexes which are master metered for water will be billed as single family accounts.
- (4) Multifamily residences are defined herein to include five (5) or more dwelling units served by a master water meter. The total monthly sewer discharge will be divided by the total number of dwelling units in the complex (regardless of current occupancy) to determine the Collection Charge blocking.

PENALTIES:

Water/Sewer utility payments are due and payable upon receipt. Payments which are not made by the date printed on the bill are subject to late payment penalties and disconnection of service.
