- 2. Discussion of the Consent Agenda.
 - a. Motion to approve a four way stop sign at the intersection of Hawthorne Avenue and Lee Street.
 - b. Motion to approve the purchase of fire personnel protective clothing utilizing Municipal Emergency Services (MES) as the City's protective clothing and turnout gear supplier at a cost of \$298,413.
 - c. Motion to approve the purchase of Fire Department uniforms utilizing North America Fire Equipment Company (NAFECO) as the annual uniform supplier at a cost of \$44,730.
 - d. Motion to approve the purchase of 40 SCBA (Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus) cylinder units for the fire department from MES (Municipal Emergency Services) at a cost of \$57,600.00.
 - e. Motion to approve Integrated Security Technologies pricing for card readers and access control on city owned facilities at a total cost of \$169,068.94.
 - f. Motion to approve Gateway Arena portable floor rehabilitation at a cost of \$25,157.50 with service work to be performed by Praters Inc.
 - a. Motion to approve Ward 4 festival for October 14, 2023 in Phillips Park.
